JUNIOR TEE-TIME POLICY – 2011

Juniors may play with an adult at any time!

Weekdays*- juniors can book from opening till 4 pm, between 4 and 6pm is reserved for the working class. Then they can play again after six.

Weekends* and Holidays- juniors playing without an adult can only book after 2:00 pm. Arrival no earlier than 1:00 pm.

****** Juniors are not permitted to be at the club prior to 1:00 pm on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays unless they have a scheduled game with an adult. They are NOT permitted to use the driving range or practice areas before 1:00pm without an adult.***

Tee times can be booked 3 days in advance, in person, over the phone or online. Booking online requires a credit card when registering. Register through the Ken-Wo website, under the heading Members, click tee times and then put in the username kenwo and the password 1921. After that set up a new profile and then you are ready to log in to book times online.

The starter is given some discretion in allowing juniors to play in periods that are “blocked out”. For example if it is 5:00 pm on a weekday with no one at the tee and a group of juniors are waiting for 6 pm the pro shop employee may decide to send them out.

Note: These junior playing restrictions will be strictly enforced. Juniors at the club prior to these times without adult supervision will be given a warning and be asked to phone home. After one warning it is expected that they understand the rules and must follow them.

DRESS CODE:

- Shorts must have pockets, zippers and presentable length. NO sport shorts! (Umbro, Adidas, baggy skateboard shorts, tennis & various types of beach shorts are unacceptable.)

- NO muscle shirts, tank tops or sweat pants - T-Shirts and hats must be presentable and contain no offensive statements. We encourage juniors to wear golf shirts whenever on the course. Shirts must be tucked in and hats on straight during all play.
- Golf or flat sole shoes are a must. NO soccer cleats!

CLINIC SCHEDULE

The clinic times and dates will be posted on the web site.

It is the responsibility of the juniors to check the website for clinic groups and times. A clinic list will also be available on the website, in the pro shop and in the junior room. They will remain with these groups for the remainder of the year, unless advised by the professional staff. Clinics prior to the end of school will be on Saturdays and in the summer on Monday or Tuesday mornings. The clinic dates and times will also be sent out to the membership via e-mail. JUNIOR GRADING SYSTEM (for use during 9 hole events at the club)

- Level 4: Tee-Off at the 150 yard marker
- Level 3: Tee-Off at the Yellow Tees
- Level 2: Tee-Off from the Green Tees
- Level 1: Tee-Off from Red (13 years of age)

This program will fall under the direction of the Professional Staff. Players will be graded to determine their level of playing ability. Placement of juniors will be determined by technical assessment of their skills and abilities. This program is designed to be flexible to allow for advancement through the program.

OUTSIDE CLUB INVITATIONALS

There are many invitational tournaments held around the province for juniors. They are relatively inexpensive and give the juniors a chance to play other courses. We encourage our junior members who have established handicaps to consider participating in these tournaments. All information about these tournaments will be posted on the bulletin board in the junior room and a provincial schedule will be posted on our website. Each member is responsible for looking after their own entry and transportation. Players traveling to these tournaments must remember to have proof of handicap.

PROPER HANDICAPS

All junior members are encouraged to keep a handicap by using the handicap computer in the pro shop. To be eligible for the club championship and tournaments in other areas players must have an established handicap. Any player adjusting another player's handicap will have their playing privileges suspended. When entering your handicap players should check the following.

1. Is it a 9 hole or an 18 hole score? Check the appropriate place.
2. Have you selected the proper tees from which you teed off? Players can have the tees they normally use set as a default.
3. Is your score a tournament score?

RESPECT ON THE COURSE

Juniors are asked to take the following into consideration when on the course.

1. Fix your ball mark on the greens.
2. Move quickly from greens to the next tee. Mark your scores after moving to the next tee.
3. Groups should be no larger
Than 4 players.
4. You are allowed 5 minutes only when looking for a lost ball. When looking for a ball wave faster groups through.
5. Players should normally let faster groups play through.
6. Players should be courteous to other members of the club. Any complaints from club members will be dealt with accordingly.
7. To speed up play move to your ball quickly and prepare to hit.
8. Tee off using the appropriate tee markers.
9. Keep your score honestly. Any cheating will NOT be tolerated.
10. Keep your carts and bags off the putting surfaces.
11. There is to be no "fooling around" on the course. This means chasing one another, throwing clubs, yelling at each other and swinging clubs that might take divots out of greens. If this occurs players will lose their playing privileges.

GIRLS CLUB

JUNIOR ROOM

We hope to make the junior room a place where juniors can go and relax prior to and after their golf game. This is where all junior communications will be posted. The room is located downstairs directly below the pro shop. We will also have a swap board for used equipment, tournament postings, a television and telephone. All juniors are reminded that this is their room and it is up to them to keep it clean. Anyone abusing this privilege will find that their playing time will be limited by the junior committee.

LOITERING

The golf course is a large operation and if you are loitering and interfering with our staff's daily duties, then we will have to ask you to leave. The backshop in particular is an area where we find juniors, please make sure you are not hanging out in the backshop, nor snooping around other golf bags.
