Club Divisions

Women's Division

KenWo has one of the most active women's division in Nova Scotia. Over 175 women take part in casual and competitive events designed to bring them together in a friendly setting on a beautiful course. All female members of KenWo who are aged 19 and over are eligible and are welcome to participate.

Every Thursday morning from early May to the end of September, tee times are reserved for Women's Division golf. Each week is a different format - casual round, team event, competitive or trophy round usually with prizes. There is a nominal participant's fee to play on Thursdays to cover the cost of prizes and trophies.

Every Tuesday Evening, there is a 9-Hole Women's Social. Come meet new people, play 9 holes, enjoy a delicious meal, win prizes! It's the perfect way to get out and enjoy KenWo! Minimal weekly fee.

Annually KenWo plays host to the Scramble Fore Cancer Care (fundraising for the Cancer Care Navigation Unit); the Women's Invitational along with the Women's Division Club Opening, Club Closing and Championship.

Men's Division

Our men's division is thriving, with support from the local business community we have a very active Men's league and Men's 9 Hole Social.

We host the annual Apple Blossom invitational in late May and the Coors Light 2-Man Scramble in the fall, attracting players from around the Maritimes to enjoy our course.

Both the Men's League and the Men's Social have a minimal weekly fee.

Seniors Men's Division

KenWo Senior Men's is your opportunity to meet and socialize with your peers, enjoy camaraderie with fellow seniors, stay fit and active while we play for numerous trophies and prizes. Any male KenWo member over 55 is eligible to join the Senior Men's on Wednesday mornings. We shuffle members and times to promote the social aspects of our group while creating balanced teams and use a variety of formats to expand the enjoyment. All of our competitions and scoring are based on percentage handicap for net scoring so every member has a chance to win every week and every competition. Our members have the option of playing 9 holes or playing "Freedom" golf where you don't have to keep score and you don't have to finish a hole. There is a fee the covers the season to join the Sr. Men.

The Sr. Men's Organization also hosts Sr. Men's Opening and Closing Events along with their Club Championship.

Social Events

KenWo is a golf "club" and as such hosts a multitude of social events and tournaments throughout the year for members and their guests.

The season begins with a Club Opening Social and ends with a Club Closing Dinner. In between these great book end events, the club hosts Nine & Dine Social evenings on Friday nights each month, as well as weekly play during the Wednesday Men's Social and the Tuesday Women's Social. The goal is for members to have opportunities to connect with others in the club, while providing an outlet to invite friends and family to the club for an evening of fun.





Junior Programs

The future of the game relies on giving kids a great experience and we're doing just that.

The program is bustling with 150 juniors taking part and is complete with weekly clinics delivered by our professionals. We offer a member only junior tour consisting of competitive and recreational tournaments with amazing support from the local business community and a strong volunteer base.

Our junior program hosts an annual junior invitational, with kids participating from around the province. We also have a fantastic Girls Club with many girls participating and learning through a combination of instruction & play. Initiation Fee

Applicable to New Adult Members

Initiation fees are to be paid in full, or you may spread the payments out over two or three years, interest free. If you leave the Club before your obligation is complete, you will be required to pay the remaining amount owed.

This fee must be paid in full in year 1 with no option to spread payment over 3 years.

Leave of Absence

Available to Current Members

Individuals: Annual fee of \$200 (Taxes In)

Paying this fee will allow the member to remain "a member in good standing" and avoid being placed on the Waiting List upon return, while also avoiding being subject to paying the Initiation Fee upon their potential return to the club as a playing member.

Purchasing of Shares



The purchase of a share is not a requirement of membership at KenWo; however, should a member(s) want to join under the Couples or Family categories, at least one Adult must be a shareholder.

Shareholder Benefits:

- The applicable shareholder membership discount, the amount of which will be determined by the Board of Directors on an annual basis. NOTE: This privilege is in effect upon entering the Share Purchase Installment Plan.
- A vote at the Annual Shareholders Meeting.
- To volunteer for an elected position on the Board of Directors.

How to purchase:

Shares may be purchased in one lump sum payment of \$750 or 3 annual installments of \$250 each.

Share Transfer policy:

Should you wish to transfer a share into your name there is a share transfer fee of \$300. If the original owner of the share is your parent or spouse the transfer fee is \$50.

Food & Beverage Minimum

All adult members of KenWo Golf Club are required to spend a minimum of \$200 (before tax and gratuity) within the Food & Beverage operation at the club before October 31st of calendar year. The minimum will be in effect when the Membership Payment is made. The minimum spend requirement includes all Food and Beverage purchases made in the Dining Room, Bar, Turn Canteen and Beverage Cart. Registration / entry fees for special events such as club tournaments, dinners, closing banquets, etc., will not count towards a members annual minimum spend requirements. There are no upfront or advance payments required for your minimum spend. Throughout the season, your purchases within the various F&B outlets at the club will be tracked under your member name, whether you pay cash, debit, credit, or charge to your House account. Should you not reach the minimum spending requirement of \$200 by October 31st, your member account will be billed for the difference. For example, Craig is an Adult member with a required spending amount of \$200 (before tax and gratuity). As of October 31st, Craig has spent \$125 in the F&B Operation throughout the season. Therefore, Craig will be billed the difference that would amount to \$75.

Food & Beverage Annual Minimums by Category

Adult (26+) - \$200

Couples - \$400 Combined amount

Family - \$400 Combined amount with spouse and junior aged members

Intermediate - (19-25)- \$150

Junior (5-18 yrs) Not Applicable

Couples:

Adults who have joined as a Couple must spend \$400 - \$200/ adult; however, they may combine their annual purchases to reach their annual minimum spend requirements. For example, Craig and Amanda have a Couples membership whereby Craig spends \$350 and Amanda spends \$50 before October 31st – they have reached their minimum F&B spend requirement for the season.

Families:

Adults who have joined as part of a Family membership are required spend a combined amount of \$400; however, food and beverage purchases made by all family members, including juniors, will be included in the annual minimum spending requirement of \$400.



Food & Beverage Members Loyalty Program

- Members earn points on all purchases made in the Food & Beverage Departments within the Club Dining Room, Bar, Turn Canteen and Beverage Cart / Satellite Bar
- KenWo loyalty points have no monetary value
- Members earn 1 Point for every dollar spent, not including tax and gratuity
- Members can redeem points for any item sold within the Food & Beverage Department

Q: How many points do I earn when I make a purchase?

You earn 1 point for every dollar spent. For example, if you purchased something from the Turn Canteen for \$5 you would receive 5 KenWo loyalty points.

Q: How do I know how many points I have?

Your loyalty points balance is noted on your member account that can be found in the member area of the website. Your loyalty balance is also reflected on your receipts from all F&B departments and Pro Shop. You can also check your balance on your monthly statement.

Q: Do my points carry over to next year?

Any unused points will not be carried forward in years. All loyalty point balances will be zeroed out on October 31st. All Loyalty Points expire annually on October 31st.

Q: How do I redeem my points?

You will require 20 x the value of the item in loyalty points to make a redemption. Loyalty Points have no Cash Value. For example; to redeem your loyalty points for a \$5 item you will need 100 Loyalty Points. Ask your server to redeem points.

Q: What if I am short loyalty points, can I pay the remaining balance in cash?

No, you must have enough loyalty points to purchase the item you want to make redemption for.

Q: Do I have to sign up for the program?

No, all KenWo members automatically earn points when they spend at the club.



Member House Account Policy

KenWo is pleased to provide all members with a charge account as part of their member privileges during the golf season. Members are permitted to charge all purchases they make at the Club to their account. For example: Food & Beverage, Pro-Shop, Carts, and Guest Green Fees etc. It is a mandatory requirement of membership that you register a valid credit card with club administration staff which will be held securely on file compliant with Canadian data protection laws. Invoices/statements are issued the first week of each month for the previous month's purchases. Sign-up for Online Accounts to view your account charges Online at anytime via your Member login on our website and visit "My Account" to see account charges. Payment of the statement will be processed on the registered credit card 14 days after the statement is issued unless the account has been settled by other means prior to this date (i.e. paid by cheque, cash, debit or email transfer). This provides all members with a minimum of two weeks to check their statement and confirm all charges before payment is processed to their credit card or paid by other means.

Booking Policy

Members can book tee times up to four (4) days in advance. Tee Times can be booked in Person; by Phone: (902) 681-5833 or Online (KenWo.ca).

Member Online Booking

Members can book tee times online (up to four days in advance) by activating their Member Account with the ProShop Staff. Once your account is activated, visit the Member Section of the website and login.

- Once you are Logged in to the members sections, click on the "book a tee time" Button
- On the next page, select your Membership Type
- Select your desired tee time
- You have up to 4 minutes to complete the booking
- All player's names in the group must be added. You can choose from the player roster to add your partners
- To prevent double bookings, the same player cannot be booked within a 5 hour period on the day that is being booked.
- Group Captain the individual reserving the tee time – will have the ability to cancel or modify the booking online via their member booking profile.
- Within 24 hours of the actual tee time, all changes MUST be made directly with the Pro Shop
- Upon completion of the booking by the Group Captain, an email confirmation will be sent to ALL group members immediately.

Other

- Adult players or walkers are required with juniors aged 8 and under; however, the maximum number of people in the group, including golfers and walkers, MUST not exceed 6 people (A MAXIMUM of 4 GOLFERS)
- Tee times can be booked up to 4 days in advance
- Maximum of 4 golfers per group
