Senior Men's Competitions

The majority of our competitions are based on Net Scores using **95% of handicap** (as used in 2023). Players therefore are required to maintain an accurate handicap and the Match committee will update its records from the Golf Canada Score Centre weekly (normally at end of day Tuesday prior to Wednesday play).

The World Handicap System relies on posting scores on the day of play. Failure to do so will result in members being excluded from certain events.

To participate in the various competitions, hole-by-hole scores for Wednesday Casual Play should be posted to the Golf Canada website (scg.golfcanada.ca) by **the end of day each Wednesday**. Competition results as usually published on Thursday.

Casual Play:

Weekly play is usually a stroke play format however there will be Stableford scoring used occasionally in the 2024 season. In organizing the draw, random draws are used which should give a variety of playing partners over the course of the season. Sign-ups will be done electronically by responding to the email generated from the GOLF GENIUS software between Thursday 6:00 am and Friday 6:00 pm. The draw is usually completed on the weekend and posted on the Ken-Wo web site on Monday, in the Pro Shop, and emailed to the Senior Men.

Each week, prizes are awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd Low Net scores or High Net Stableford scores. Weekly scores also count toward the season long Low Net Ringer Board Competition. The tie breaker for this competition, if needed, will be highest number of birdies.

From time to time, instead of individual play, members will play a team format. Examples might include: Stableford – 4 man teams; 4 Ball Better Ball - 2 man teams; "1-2-3 Best Ball" format; Pinehurst, Multiplier,

Match Play – Babcock Trophy:

This is a season long 18 hole **Match Play** competition. Play begins in late May and usually concludes in early September. Participants are arranged into four pools based on HCI and then paired for their match on regular Casual Play days. On rare occasions, Matches may occur on a day other that a Wednesday at the discretion of the Match Committee. The results posted on the Bulletin Board. Prizes are awarded to the pool winners and for 1st and 2nd place.

Trophy Competitions

Various season long competitions are held to reward Low Gross and Low Net scores. Gross and net scores are recorded by the Match Chair each week.

- Low Net:
 - o The Lindsay Trophy is awarded for the best Senior Low Net score for the season,
 - o **Eaves Trophy** is awarded for the best **Super Senior Low Net** score for the season
- Low Gross:
 - o The Palmeter Cup is awarded for the overall Senior single Low Gross score for the season.
 - o The Rockwell Cup is awarded for the overall Super Senior single Low Gross score for the season.
- Super Senior 9 Holes Category (70 years of age and above):
 - o Scotia McLeod Trophy is awarded for the best Low Gross front 9 score for the season.
 - Canada Trust Trophy is awarded for the best Low Net front 9 score for the season.

Giffin Cup: This is a fun team event at the Senior Men's Closing. A random draw creates teams of comparable ability and competition is for various prizes and the coveted Giffin Cup.

Senior Men's Club Championship:

Open to all Senior male golfers at Ken-Wo, this is a two day competition being held August 19&20 this year. Division Four is played from the Red tees with separate prizes inside the divisions.
